



Travelling to and parking at Neuadd y Gwendraeth, Drefach, Llanelli

Parking is limited at Neuadd y Gwendraeth, therefore we ask you to consider your options for travelling to the venue. We have implemented a Green Travel Plan which is the Government's recommended way forward to widen travel choice, to promote more sustainable travel choices and to reduce single occupancy car travel. We encourage you to consider the following options for alternative travel arrangements –

Car sharing

There are many benefits to car sharing e.g. reducing the demand for parking spaces, sustainability, financial savings, health and wellbeing, engaging with others, improving the air quality and the environment. If you attend the hall regularly with the same group of people, why not ask who would like to car share?

Bus links

Neuadd y Gwendraeth is a five minute walk from Drefach square where several bus routes are available. The link below lists timetables for this stop – Routes 129, 164 and 166.

Rail links

Neuadd y Gwendraeth is a 20 minute taxi ride from Carmarthen Station and roughly a 30 minute drive from Llanelli Station.

Coach hire

Visitors are able to arrive by private coach minimising the number of cars. We have a large bus bay at the front of the venue for coaches to drop off and collect visitors.

PARKING OPTIONS

If you do arrive by car, please note that car parking is limited on site with approximately 16 spaces at the rear of the venue (including 2 disabled spaces). Visitors can also park along the access road and also within the large bus bay at the front of the venue.

There is a significant area available for parking within the closed school site adjacent to the venue. However, access routes are not signposted and at night there is poor visibility. Consequently we urge you to exercise care. You can access this area by following the map on the reverse of this guidance.

Please do NOT park within the following areas (please see map of areas referred to on reverse):

- On the junction to the residential area opposite the bus bay
- In front of driveways and access roads to private property
- On any part of private road signposted as 'Hen Ffordd'

Stewards

There will be a staff member on site to oversee parking, but it would be greatly appreciated if organisations staging large events at the hall could supply volunteer stewards to assist. These stewards should report to the staff member on site for information and guidance.
